Dear Sigma Nu,

Thank you for reporting a possible violation of the LSU Code of Student Conduct. The organization notified the University of the concerns in advance of the University having knowledge of the incident and has been granted Registered Student Organization (RSO) non-medical amnesty. The student(s) involved in the incident will be addressed by SAA. The organization has complied with the steps outlined in section 3.4 Amnesty of the Code of Student Conduct. The educational outcomes below have been established in partnership with Greek Life/SAA and the chapter to address the behavior, and must be completed to qualify for amnesty.

As a result of the incident that occurred on September 22, 2018, where an active member of Sigma Nu Fraternity asked new members to drink alcohol in response to incorrectly answering quiz questions, the following will occur:

Items that have already been completed include:

- The active member was evicted from the chapter house and has began the resignation process. (The High Council needs to vote on the member's resignation.)
- The chapter president address the chapter informing members about the incident and that this type of behavior will not be tolerated by any member of Sigma Nu.
- Sigma Nu's national consultant presented a mental health workshop to all members.

The following items will be completed and submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the [online reporting form](#).

1. Lead Chairman will present a different look at hazing workshop for both the active chapter and new member class by December 3, 2018. Agenda and date will be shared with SAA by December 10, 2018.
2. During all social events at the Phi Chapter house, dorm areas will be closed off to all members including those that live in the fraternity house.
